## HISTORY OF *STOCKINGS FOR KIDS*

B101 has been giving back to the community through *Stockings for Kids* since 1996. This program gives toys to thousands of children in the Delaware Valley who would otherwise go without. B101 has long believed in giving back to the community and what better way than to partner with the Salvation Army of Greater Philadelphia – an organization dedicated to meeting the human needs of men, women and children in the community throughout the year.

Launched as *Kids for Kids*, B101's stocking stuffer program reached out to the schools and children of Philadelphia for help in making holiday dreams come true. That first year, B101 distributed empty stockings to schools throughout the area. Thousands of children, their parents and teachers helped to fill over 15,000 stockings, totaling \$160,000 in donations.

Over the past fourteen years *Stockings for Kids* has become a beloved Philadelphia tradition. To date, the program has raised more than \$13 million in toys and donations for distribution by The Salvation Army. What began as a school-focused fundraiser has grown into a movement that includes thousands of individuals, schools, corporations and community groups pitching in together every holiday season to help those who need it the most.

Local media and business giants have stepped up to do their part as well. This is the ninth year that B101 has partnered with [NBC10](#), [Boscov's](#), our second year with Philadelphia-based [Pep Boys](#) and our first with VWR International, LLC. The goal for this year is to help make this holiday season brighter for as many children as possible.

## FAQ'S – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **How do I request stockings?** The only way to request stockings is by submitting a form on our website. It's simple, fast and easy! Instructions on using the website are included below. NOTE: You do NOT have to fill a stocking to participate in the program. You can donate new, unwrapped toys!
- **Can my presents be wrapped?** Unfortunately not. Due to Salvation Army safety regulations all toy and clothing donations must be unwrapped.
- **Do I have to put a topper on my stocking?** Yes. The information provided on the topper (intended age and gender of the recipient) is crucial to The Salvation Army – with thousands of stockings to distribute this information aids them in making sure that, for example, a six year old boy does not receive a teething rattle and a sleeper.
- **How important is the school prize incentive form?** The form is also used as a summary of your school's participation; it's important to us and especially to you! Not only is it vital to our management and evaluation of the program, it's the OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM that allows us to determine which schools donated the most stockings and new, unwrapped toys!
- **How much or little should I put in my stocking?** Each filled stocking is valued at approximately \$15 to \$20; use this range as your guide. However you are not obligated to provide gifts within this range...you can be as generous or as thrifty as you want or need to be. The children of the Delaware Valley appreciate each and every contribution you make!
- **What if my gift won't fit in a stocking?** Large and odd shaped toy donations are welcomed. Please make sure that a topper is securely tied or taped to your donation so we are sure of the age and gender of the child to whom you are donating.
- **Do you accept used toys or clothing?** No. All gift donations should be new. If you wish to donate used toys or clothing, please contact your local Salvation Army about a direct donation.
- **What if I want to donate a bike or very large toy?** All toy donations are welcomed. Please let your drop-off location know when you are bringing in a large shipment of filled stockings or an especially large gift donation.
- **Can my stockings be picked up from my school or business?** No. Due to the sheer volume of donations and the timeliness of the program all donations must be delivered to your local Salvation Army branch or a Pep Boys near you.
- **How important is the final stocking drop-off deadline date of 12/22/09?** *VERY IMPORTANT!* We cannot guarantee that stockings dropped-off after this date will make it into the hands of the children of the Delaware Valley for the Holidays. However, if for some reason you drop stockings off after this date, they will be distributed to kids before the New Year.
- **What if I don't have time to shop for gifts, but I still want to contribute?** Please go to our website at [www.B101radio.com](http://www.B101radio.com) and click on Stockings for Kids. You can use your credit card to give as much or as little as you can afford.
- **How are the stockings/toys distributed?**

### *Stockings for Kids Distribution Statement*

All stockings/toys collected through the *Stockings for Kids* program are delivered to and distributed by The Salvation Army. Individual recipients are selected through a standard Salvation Army application screening process and stockings/toys are **distributed without discrimination** – including, but not limited to, race and religion – and in line with The Salvation Army's global mission.
